



## FACILITIES

The Cuyahoga Valley Environmental Education Center is home for our residential camps. The Center is a 500-acre site in Cuyahoga Valley National Park, mixing wooded trails with modern dormitories, dining halls, science labs, an art room and much more. All facilities are wheelchair accessible.

## STAFF

Low camper-to-counselor ratios promote a safe, family atmosphere in which teamwork and individual expression flourish. National Park Service rangers, professional chefs, artists, faculty and CVNPA staff are all a part of the summer camp team. Camp sessions are staffed by a summer camp nurse, available 24 hours a day, and on-site food service that provides snacks and three meals each day. Counselors and staff are First-Aid and CPR certified. Residential camps are American Camp Association accredited.



## TUITION DISCOUNTS

Cuyahoga Valley National Park Association members at the Rock (Family) level and above receive \$20 off residential camp fees and \$10 off day camp fees. Families who register before May 1, 2010 receive \$20 off residential camp fees and \$10 off day camp fees. Returning residential campers bringing a NEW camper with them will both receive \$20 off their registration fee (must be received in same envelope or called in at the same time).

At Junior Ranger Day Camp in Cuyahoga Valley National Park, every day is a new and exciting adventure. This unique program gives campers the opportunity to explore, interact with rangers, make new friends, and become Junior Rangers of Cuyahoga Valley National Park. Campers will spend their days outside exploring the forests, streams, meadows, and trails surrounding Happy Days Lodge. At the end of the week the campers will have completed the requirements to become Junior Rangers and will receive their badges in a ceremony for friends and family. The badge ceremony will take place Friday at 3 p.m.

Day Camp will take place at Happy Days Lodge. The facility is located on State Route 303, 2 miles east of the Village of Peninsula and 1 mile west of State Route 8.
